LUNCH AT THE COWFISH SUSHI BURGER BAR

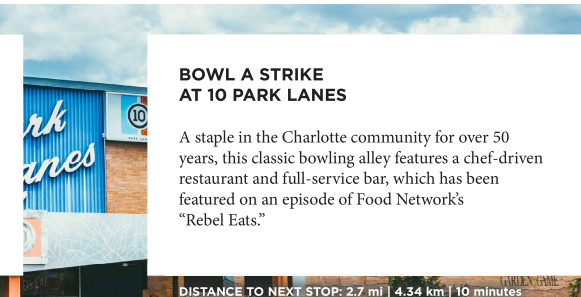
