LUNCH AT SALUD CERVECERIA

Enjoy an eclectic pizza menu, featuring Latin Lingo with chicken, crema, elote and jalapenos, or Liberation with rosemary and thinly sliced potatoes, and choose from a variety of craft beers and non-alcoholic options.

ENJOY DESSERT AT POPBAR

For a sweet treat head to Popbar, which offers more than 50 flavors of handcrafted gelato, sorbet and yogurt. With the dessert in tow, stroll around the neighborhood to soak up the small-town vibes.

EVENING

TOUR, DINNER AND DRINKS AT CAMP NORTH END

Hang out at this 75-acre, historic industrial site, which once manufactured Model T cars. Start at the foot of the water tower to learn about the ambitious project's history and then kick back with food, music and Friday night fun in the Boileryard. Pose for a picture in front of the large Clint Eastwood mural.
