DIY AT PADDYWAX CANDLE BAR

Bring a unique gift home for friends and family at Paddywax Candle Bar, a hand-poured candle shop in South End. With a variety of scents and vessels to choose from, this is one of the coolest experiences in the Queen City.

LUNCH AT MAC'S SPEED SHOP

In the mood for barbecue? This local restaurant and bar has it all: smoked wings, hickory smoked and pulled pork barbecue, cornmeal fried catfish and St. Louis ribs. Snap a picture in front of Willie Nelson's portrait, with text reading "Willie for President."
